



St. Catharine School Certification of COVID -19 Travel Advisory Quarantine Compliance

The NJ Department of Health has published a 14 day quarantine travel advisory which states that individuals who have traveled from NJ to a state mentioned in the link below are to self-quarantine for 14 days to protect others from the possible transmission of COVID-19.

Please read this document for specific guidance and recommendations from the NJ Department of Health.

Much time, effort, and expense has been put forth to reduce the risk of COVID-19 exposure at St. Catharine School in order to allow in-person instruction to occur as the 2020-2021 school year opened and continues. It is required that all students, along with members of their households, and faculty members, comply with the self-quarantine directives and instructions as a condition for continued participation and welcome back for in-person instruction. The Department of Catholic Schools in the Diocese of Trenton, is also supporting these protocols.

Therefore, it is required that the parents of all students, as well as all employees, advise St. Catharine School administration in writing of travel to an identified state on the NJ Department of Health list and acknowledge that they will follow the protocols for self-quarantine directives and instructions posted there.
